

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

No dog will be admitted without proof of up to date vaccinations as follows:-

Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis and Parvovirus.

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES MUST BE PRODUCED ON EACH OCCASION A DOG IS BOARDED

No dog suspected to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be admitted.

Each boarder will be charged for the day of admission regardless of the time of arrival. No charge however will be made for the day of departure as long as your dog/s are collected before 10.30am

WE ACCEPT CASH OR CHEQUES. CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO WINDMILL COTTAGE KENNELS.

In the event of a dog not being collected within 2 weeks of the notified date of departure and there being no communication from the owner, we reserve the right to re-home the dog as we see fit as it will be considered they have been abandoned.

Whilst your dog is boarded with us you give us permission to seek veterinary treatment if necessary. We will always try to use the owners own vet first but if unable to we will use our own vet. We are happy to administer medication, but please ensure we have clear written instructions and sufficient medication for the duration of their stay, and it is advisable for us to have extra in case of a delayed collection. Please ensure your pets are up to date with their flea and worm treatment.

Whilst all reasonable precautions will be taken to care for the clients pets, due to the uncertainty of animal behaviour and compatibility the kennels does not accept any liability to damage to any animals (whether in its care or stewardship) save where such injury or damage arises directly from the kennels negligence.

All beds and bedding will be supplied by the kennels, although you may like to bring your own. It is understood that whilst all reasonable care and attention is given, all belongings such as beds, blankets, toys, etc are left at the owner's risk.

By boarding your dog on each occasion with Windmill Cottage Kennels you are agreeing to these terms and conditions
